

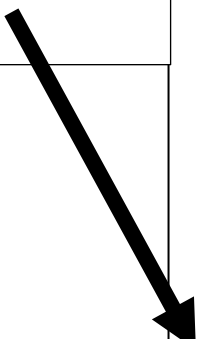
Immediately following this program, the Annual Meeting of the UW-Madison Retirement Association will be held.

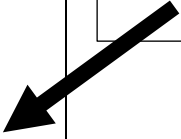
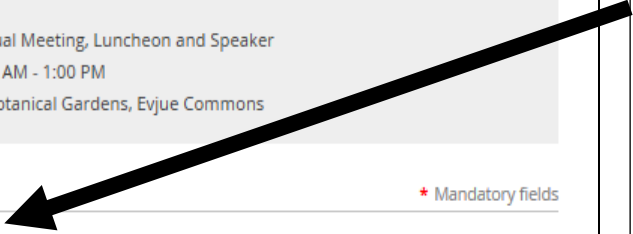
